Eddie -Behshad and I took a look at the STIP projects as you requested today. We overlaid the AQ area, county boundaries, mpo boundaries, model area, and TIP projects in TransCAD (see attached) It appears only one project is outside of CAMPO but within the modeled area, that is the Clayton Bypass project, and that is a tiny portion.

Since this is coming out of CAMPO, do you need a table of this or could that just be considered a continuation of the CAMPO project? Outside of that, there is no other project showing graphically that appears to qualify. There is nothing in Orange County or Chatham.
